For more than a decade, Harlem All-Stars Theater Group (HASTG) has empowered Harlem youth through professional theatre training, academic enrichment, and mentorship from industry leaders. Now, we are taking the next step: becoming an official 501(c)(3) and securing a permanent home to expand our reach and deepen our impact.

The Opportunity: A Permanent Home in Harlem

Location: 116–122 East 124th Street (18,400 sq ft)

• Two Floors: 3rd (9,200 sq ft) and 5th (9,200 sq ft)

• Annual Lease: \$828,000 (\$69,000/month)

• Turnkey-Ready: Minor updates only (paint, staging, décor)

Why It Matters: Harlem needs a permanent hub for rehearsals, performances, tutoring, mentorship, wellness, and community programs. No more displacements. This is home.

The facility will feature:

- Stage & rehearsal rooms
- TV/film & podcast studios
- Fitness & wellness center
- Classrooms & tutoring space
- Offices, conference rooms, kitchen

Bathrooms with showers & lockers

It will also be available for community rental, filling a critical gap in Harlem, where only one comparable venue currently exists.

Our Impact So Far

- 500+ youth served since founding
- 90% from underserved Harlem communities
- Students advance to college, scholarships, and careers in arts, STEM, medicine, and education
- Parents inspired to pursue higher education themselves
- Alumni now educators, leaders, and contributors to the Harlem community

5-Year Growth & Revenue Projection

Year 1 — Foundation (~\$861K revenue, \$1.87M need)

- Establish 501(c)(3), lease space, build out stage & studios.
- 100 students, 2–3 productions, \$350K rentals, \$250K grants.

Year 2 — Growth (~\$1.0M revenue)

- Expand to 150 students, increase productions & rentals.
- Strengthen board (20 members) & corporate sponsorship base.

Year 3 — Momentum (~\$1.1M revenue)

- 200 students, 3–4 productions, \$400K+ rentals.
- Expand foundation partnerships & add national grants.

Year 4 — Scale (~\$1.28M revenue)

- Full program capacity: 250+ students.
- Rentals & sponsorships drive growth beyond \$1M budget.

Year 5 — Sustainability (~\$1.47M revenue)

- A Harlem anchor institution serving 300+ students.
- Strong reserves/endowment (\$20K+/year growth).
- Recognized regional model for youth arts & education.
